
THINGS TO DO ONCE YOU HAVE MOVED HOUSE









BILLS

Make sure to contact all service providers such as gas, electricity, telephone, TV licence, council tax, internet and water suppliers at your old property with your new address and meter readings on the day you move out. Do the same for the property you move to so you know you will be connected and billed from they day you move in.

INSURANCE

Make sure you update your house insurance once you have exchanged contracts. It is important to update your car insurance and any life or healthcare insurance. Be sure to update your vehicle registration document for your car to ensure your insurance remains valid.

HEALTHCARE

Be sure to update your GP & Dentist records for yourself and anyone who will be living at your new home. If you have children you will need to advise their nursery/school as well as the Child Benefit office.

FINANCES

Update your records for your bank account, credit card or savings account with the different banks. Let your employer know for their HR records but also for important documents like payslips.

IDENTIFICATION

It is important to update your driving licence with your new address as well as any other identification that requires your address such as a bus pass. If you receive any form of benefits you will need to update the relevant agency.

DELIVERIES

If you have anything delivered to your home such as milk, newspapers, groceries or even regular internet orders, make sure your accounts all show your new address for the next time you need a delivery.
